### Here are 3 key Bible verses about overcoming fear for kids!

In Isaiah, God commands us not to fear. Plus, He tells us why we don't have to be afraid ~ because He is with us! <u>He promises to strengthen us and help us.</u> "Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you. I will uphold you with My righteous right hand. (Isaiah 41:10)

Psalm 23 repeats the same idea: "...I will fear no evil; For you are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. (Psalm 23:4b)

And again, in Joshua, God says the same thing:

"Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go. (Joshua 1:9)

#### God is greater than your kids' fears

When you teach your kids from God's Word about fear, you'll help them realize that:

- 1. God can handle the things they are afraid of.
- 2. They can trust God to handle the things they are afraid of.

3. If they trust God to handle the things they are afraid of, they don't have to be afraid anymore!

That truth is not just for kids.

If you can successfully teach these Bible lessons on fear for children, then you set them up for a lifetime of trusting the Lord and living without fear. That is huge.

#### Effectively teach kids what the Bible says about Fear.

How do you teach your kids what God says about fear in a way that's memorable and meaningful? Here are a few simple ideas for you!

#### 1. Sleep on it.

- To help me overcome my fear of the dark, my parents hung God's word on the wall opposite my bed. But think you could do even better than that ~ put His truth directly on the pillow where you kids lay their heads!
- Or, you could make your own pillowcases too! Simple copy the verse of your choice onto a blank pillowcase using a fabric marker or a permanent marker.

#### 2. Drink from it.

Give your kids water bottles with Scripture verses!

Fear Not ~ Insulated Straw Tumbler

#### 3. Hang it on the wall.

This is another simple craft that creates a useful reminder of God's truth about fear.

Give each child a sheet of paper or cardstock.

Show them how to use this "Faith>Fear" to create a message based on God's Word about not being afraid.

- Let the kids decorate the page using the craft supplies you may have.
- Tell the kids to hang up their pictures where they will see them frequently. And encourage them to remember, every time they see their picture, what God's Word says about fear

#### 4. Listen to it.

It's always a good idea to absorb God's truth in more than one way, if possible.

You've looked at what Scripture says about Fear. Now listen to it!

#### 5. Sing it!

Music may be the most powerful learning method that I know of. I have forgotten many things I've read, heard, or done. But I have forgotten very few of the song I've learned.

#### 6. Wear it.

The simple act of getting dressed could become a prompt that helps your kids remember to trust God when they're afraid ~ if they have a shirt with God's statements about fear. You could also make a shirt with fabric markers. Write the verse on the shirt and decorate it.

# God's word is powerful. Use it to help your kids banish fear, and you'll enjoy watching the difference it can make in everyday life.

#### **RESOLUTION 3: ON LOVE LIFE AMENDMENT**

WHEREAS, Louisiana Baptists have declared our unwavering commitment to rescue and protect life from the womb through eternity; and

WHEREAS, that commitment includes our pledge to continue to fight for the rights of the unborn and the care of their mothers; and

WHEREAS, state judges in 13 states, most recently this year in Kansas, have ignored legal precedent, or the actual language, or both, regarding their state constitutions to declare an unwritten but inherent right to an abortion, thus overturning common-sense protections for the unborn and their mothers in their laws; and

WHEREAS, in a move to prevent such action in Louisiana, the overwhelming majority of our state legislators in 2019 approved a constitutional amendment stating, "To protect human life, nothing in this Constitution shall be construed to secure or protect a right to abortion or require the funding of abortion"; and

WHEREAS, this proposed state constitutional amendment will be a ballot measure in the 2020 fall elections; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, that we, the messengers to this 172nd session of the Louisiana Baptist Convention, meeting in Alexandria, Louisiana, November 11-12, 2019, unequivocally reaffirm we are pro-life; and be it further.

**RESOLVED**, that we most strongly urge our lawmakers to continue to write legislation and pass laws that protect human life, especially the lives of the unborn and their mothers; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that we give our strongest possible endorsement of the Love Life Amendment and the constitutional protection it affords against unilateral actions to undo pro-life laws: and be it finally

**RESOLVED**, that we urge all eligible Louisiana Baptists to register and to vote for the Love Life Amendment and to encourage others to do likewise in order to overwhelmingly pass this 2020 ballot measure.

Unanimously passed Nov. 12 by messengers to the 2019 annual meeting of the Louisiana Baptist Convention.

#### What's the Love Life Amendment All About?

Love Life.

As New York and other states are moving to legalize abortion up to the very moment before a baby is born, Louisiana must act to show its love for life! The Love Life Amendment is the final piece of the puzzle to ensure that Louisiana protects unborn babies from abortion the minute Roe v. Wade is reversed. #### **HELPING HANDS STOREFRONT HISTORY**

The inspiration for the ministry was given to Modie Phillips, Chairman of the Vernon Baptist Missions Committee in 1991 as a result of Desert Storm. The news of the swift departure of troops was given on the KALB News Channel. A child of an American service member was telling how bad she felt because her Mother was crying and said she had no one to help her. The child did not know what to do. Praying and asking for God's leadership Modie Phillips called the main chapel at

Ft. Polk asking the chaplain there what could be done to help. The Chaplain said collecting and giving food to the families would be good since this was much needed. Modie Phillips then approached the churches of Vernon Baptist Association asking for their help in the donation and distribution of food for these families. Upon request, Ft. Polk Army Community Services sent the families who needed the food to Castor Baptist Church, the location of the food distribution. Many military families were helped by this event.

As a result of this and the publicity, hungry families began calling; many saying their children were hungry. With inspiration from God and prayer Modie Phillips, Chairman of the Vernon Baptist Missions committee approached the churches of this Association with a request of financial sponsorship. The churches responded and the ministry began with 64 families receiving food in the beginning month, which was distributed from East Leesville Baptist Church, continuing monthly during 1992.

The Vernon Baptist Association elected Modie Phillips as Director of Helping Hands Storefront in 1992.

Food is received in agreement with The Food Bank Of Central Louisiana and is now given to approximately <u>300 families each month.</u>

The Ministry continued to grow, as the ministry was then located to the former Porter Western Store until 2000.

A building at 603 South Third Street in Leesville was found and purchased by Helping Hands Storefront. The ministry then relocated there. As the ministries grew a request was made by the mission through the Vernon Baptist Association to the Louisiana Ministries and Missions Department of the Louisiana Baptist Convention seeking volunteer workers to build on a lot purchased by the ministry at 620 South

Third. Louisiana Campers On Mission built the building in 2002 under the guidance of team leader Philip Granger.

The ministry continued to outgrow the space. A request for help was again made through the Vernon Baptist Association to The Louisiana Baptist Missions and Ministries Department of the Louisiana Baptist Convention for volunteer builders. The request was granted. The Baptist Men's Ministry of the Louisiana Baptist Convention led by team leader Steve Hayes, local volunteers and volunteers from several states built the building at the present location at 518 South Third Street. Other ministries offered at the mission are:

Worship Services each Friday morning. The main purpose for the total ministry is to present God's Son Jesus Christ and salvation through Him to all who enter the doors of this mission.

<u>The Clothes Center Ministry began</u> as people started donating clothing and other items to the Mission in 1993. This main focus for this ministry is to distribute clothing to those in need. Clothing to the public is offered for a small donation price. <u>The Home Center Thrift Store</u> and Home <u>Crisis Center</u> began in 1993 and give household items and furniture to victims of burnout and other crisis situations. The general public may also purchase items. All workers are volunteers thus allowing all money collected to be put back into the total ministry.

<u>English as a Second Language</u> tutoring classes were started in 1993 with a plea given to Modie Phillips, Director by the pastor of Sandy Hill Spanish Mission for their church people to learn English. Students from many countries have benefited from these classes with some gaining their citizenship in this country that they have chosen as their adopted country. Classes and books are free.

<u>School Supplies Distribution</u> is held each August. This ministry began in 1995 as the need was seen for children to not be ashamed that they do not have the supplies that they need for school. Supplies are given to approximately 250 children each year before the opening of school.

<u>Shop With A Cop Christmas For Children</u> was started in 1996. Modie Phillips, Director realized the need for this ministry as she was unloading the trunk of her car on a food distribution day. In the trunk were a few broken toys left from a toy collection given to the children of the Cheyenne River Sioux in South Dakota. Modie and her husband J.D. worked with the Louisiana Campers On Mission to build a church there for the Indian people.

A man saw the broken toys and asked if he could have them. He said he could repair them and that this would be the only gifts that his children would receive for Christmas. It was at that moment that God put upon the heart of Modie Phillips the need for a Christmas gift ministry. Helping Hands Storefront volunteers work together with local law enforcement, Wal-Mart, Energy Transfer and other donors to help the children have a happier Christmas. There are approximately 200 children each year who shop for their Christmas gifts with the help of a law enforcement officer. A fundraiser is held each year in November with all proceeds and donations paying for the children's Christmas. Prior to this the children had received used repaired toys.

Modie Phillips, Director says that the 60 volunteers who serve at Helping Hands Storefront in the ministry to which God has called them are <u>the heart of the total</u> <u>ministry</u>.

Modie Phillips, Director of Helping Hands Storefront announced her retirement effective July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Modie has served as Helping Hands Storefront Director since it's beginning 28 years ago.

It has been my privilege and honor to serve as Helping Hands Storefront Director. I will miss my coworkers and the many people that I have come to love as we have served them over the years. I know that God will continue to bless this mission as He has in the past years.

The Missions and Ministries Department of the Louisiana Baptist Convention honored Modie Phillips in 2008 for having served as Director of Helping Hands Storefront for 16 years.

Modie Phillips was honored with a certificate of appreciation by the state of Louisiana in 2017 for serving the people of Vernon Parish for 25 years.

Modie Phillips serves as a state volunteer missionary with the North American Mission Board, Southern Baptist Convention.
