

Psalm 23:3 He restores my soul

Soul - life

Psalm 42:11, "Why art thou cast down, 0 my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God."

Cast - cannot get up by itself.

Psalm 23 is about the LORD as our Shepherd. A problem sheep have is that they become cast down and cannot get up. But the good news is the LORD restores.

1 Cor. 10:12, "Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall."

Christians become cast by:

- 1. Looking for the soft comfortable spot.
- 2. Having too much wool. Galatians 2:20, "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me."
- 3. Comparing material success to spiritual success. Rev. 3:17, "Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:".

Restoreth - bring back to a place once enjoyed.

- 1. Restores through reverence, John 4:23-24.
- 2. Restores through reminders, Eph. 1:3.
- 3. Restores through replenishing, Isaiah 40:31.
- 4. Restores through resolving conflicts, James 5:16.
- 5. Restores through relieving tension, Philippians 4:6-7.
- 6. Restores through refocusing, Psalm 23:1.
- 7. Restores through repositioning, Col. 3:1-3.

I pray as you study this further that it will bless your soul.

Dear Students,


Thanks for a great time last month! Mrs. Devon and I really enjoyed spending time with you in fellowship and Bible study.

We have a RAC coming up this month on Sunday, May 26th. I hope that you would join us and invite friends.


