Our Testimony of Tithing

Alycia and I began tithing early in our marriage way before I became a pastor. We were both very young living from payday to payday. At that time I didn't know anythina about the inner workings of the churches we were members of at the different duty stations we lived at. All we knew was that they were Southern Baptist that supported the great mission work thru the co-operative program. These churches also preached the whole counsel of God. We were giving to the Lord Jesus from grateful hearts and working every day and raising a family in the military like most young families that we associated with. Our 10 percent of our income and the offerings we gave was probably not even close to other church member's abundance but we were sacrificing just as much as anybody else. At that time I didn't know but I do know now that in Heaven's eyes it is about equal sacrifices and not equal gifts in giving. The Lord also looks at the motive of the heart. Well, many years have passed and any financial blunders thru the years were not the Lord's fault but mine. Yet, someway and somehow God has always taken care of us from leaving a good career in the USAF and going into the ministry with a family, to resigning a church pastorate without any place to go. Faith plus beans and rice! Still one of my favorite meals! There may come a time in these latter days that all Christians (not just the ones in Islamic countries) may have to choose between your money (and all possessions) and your walk with the Lord Jesus. I believe that Alycia and I have already made our hearts ready if need be for that decision about 30 years ago when we decided to give back to the Lord 10 percent and offerings when we didn't have much to start with but the Lord provided. Today we are very grateful of His blessings. If we could go back 30 years and redo some things we probably would. And if we could go back, we promise you we would never change the decision about tithing.

This is our personal testimony about tithing to the Lord from a heart that loves Him above everything else and our testimony of tithing in support of the church family that we are active members of. It is also our testimony of giving support to thousands of Southern Baptist missionaries. These missionaries are called by the Lord Jesus, highly qualified; seminary trained (at least a Master's Degree), and approved by a local church. We thru the local Southern Baptist Church have helped support thousands of these missionaries in these years we have tithed. May the Lord Jesus allow us many more years! I only share this so that you my brothers and sisters know that your pastor does not encourage you to do something that I'm not doing myself and have been doing for years. I do leave you with a question. What testimony do you have before your church family and before our Lord in giving? It is not too late if you do not have a testimony of giving. With faith and repentance I know our Savior is gracious beyond what we can ask or think.
